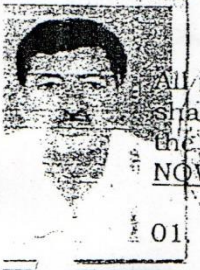
This deed of Trust Deed is executed on this 01/07/2019 at Pulwama by:-

AND WHEREAS the TRUSTEES shall be

- 1. Khalid Rashid Reshi S/O Muhammad Abdullah Reshi R/O Dangerpora Pulwama (Founder Member)
- 2. Dr. Abdul Aziz Dar S/O Abdul Ahad Dar R/O Dangerpora Pulwama
- 3. Mukhtar Ahmad Magray S/O Ali Muhammad Magray R/O Nowpora Payeen Pulwama
- 4. Nazir Ahmad Magray S/O Ali Muhammad Magray R/O Nowpora Payeen Pulwama
- 5. Rayees Ahmad Mir S/O Bashir Ahmad Mir R/O Gudoora Pulwama
- 6. Syed Hamid Ullah Andrabi S/O Syed Ghulam Muhammad R/O Zadoora Pulwama

All the above said parties will be collectively called the TRUSTEES which expression shall include them, the survivors of them and the executors and administrators of the last survivor or the Trustees for the time being of the Trust created hereby.
NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITHNESES AS FOLLOWS :

- 01. The name of the Trust shall be 'S.I.M.A.R.G. Memorial Trust at Dangerpora Pulwama'
- 02. That the registered office of the Trust shall be situated at Dangerpora PULWAMA, KASHMIR India, or at such other place or places as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time. Branch / administrative offices can be opened in any part of the country for the smooth functioning of the Trust.
- That the objectives of the Trust shall be wholly for the public purposes and incomes shall be applied for the same and accumulated in India wholly for public & charitable purposes without prejudice to generality of provisions aforesaid and the following shall be deemed to be the principal objectives of **TRUST :**
- 04. That the trustees have already contributed an amount of Rs.50000/- for the creation of the said trust and to carry its objectives in future. The Trustee No.1 shall be the founder member of the trust.

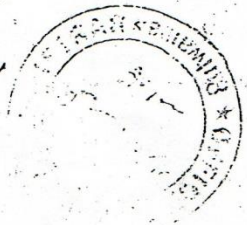


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The aims and objectives of the Trust shall be as follows: -

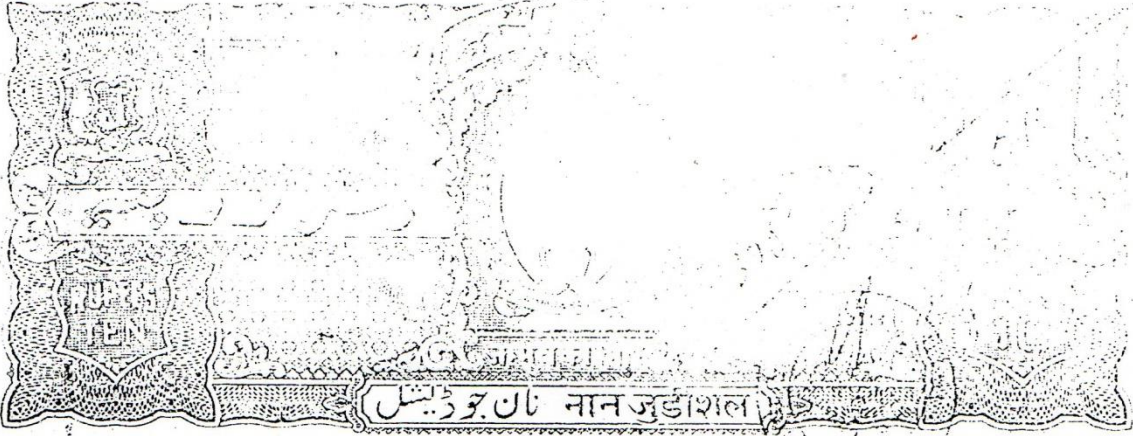

1. Construction and running of Paramedical Colleges, hospitals, B-Ed Colleges, ETT/NTT Institutions, M-Ed Colleges, Law Colleges, Schools, Technical College, colleges, education institutions, Centers for poor feeding and homes for the aged for the benefit of the public.
2. Providing grants, scholarships, fellowships and other forms of financial assistance to the needy and deserving students for pursuing education, vocational training, skill development etc.
3. Granting of financial assistance to any institution for granting scholarships, prizes, medals, awards for excellence in studies, sports and scientific research, distribution of books and note books for poor and deserving students.
4. Establishment, conduct, maintenance of clinical laboratories, hospitals, nursing homes, paramedical colleges, dispensaries and institutions of similar nature and providing financial assistance to the deserving persons for medical treatment, in any medical institution.
5. Establishment, conduct, maintenance of old age homes, homes for physically challenged men, women and children and persons with similar disabilities and also for granting financial assistance to institutions performing similar activities.
6. Grant of donation to any Temple, Mosque, Church, Gurudwara and other places of worship and / or religious institutions. However, the Trust shall not undertake any religious activities.
7. Providing for or contributing to education and scientific research and development.
8. Providing relief to the poor and advancing any other object of general public utility.

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9. To impart programmed, systematic and adequate knowledge to the students through suitable reforms so as to keep pace with new global developments;
10. To develop, exploit and nurture the latent and patent capabilities of individuals in the institutions of Education, Culture, Sociology, Handicrafts, Handlooms, Environment, Technology, Vocational Education, Non-Formal Education and Medical / Para-Medical Education.
11. To bring about overall development of human resource in the field of higher education so as to ensure quality high education as contemplated in National Policy of Education.
12. To improve the moral and social standards of the people particularly those who are either totally illiterate or half way educated in the area(s) specified for the purpose by way of diversion to other job oriented / professional courses/ training such as Handicrafts/ Handlooms, Tourism Trade, Forest Conservation, Watershed Programmes, Agricultural and Horticulture Development/ Rural Development, Public Health/ Hygiene and Paramedical activities.
13. To arrange long/ short term Training Course, Seminars, Exhibitions, outside Tours within and outside the State / Country and other types of such programmes with a view to improving the standards of education in general and encouraging the intelligent / hardworking people/ students of rural / backward areas in particular.
14. To educate/ promote the professional interest of all persons engaged or interested in connection with Environmental Management, Pollution Monitoring and Control, Natural Resources Conservation, Environmental Education by organizing and implementation of various training programmes/ research programmes/ market promotion activities of Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Floriculture/ Handicrafts/ Handlooms.
15. To make special plans for studies and research in the fields of Eco-System, Entho-biology, Wild Life Preservation and Cultural Heritage.

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16. To coordinate the action undertaken in pursuance of the above mentioned programmes and projects so as to ensure their effective implementation including co-operation from State / Central Governments and the Non-Governmental agencies as well as international funding with similar projects with a view to enlisting their support.
17. To establish and maintain libraries/ Training Centres/ Vocational Institutions/ Health and Medical Institutions and equip them with books and related equipment for general benefit of the rural/ urban people.
18. To subscribe, affiliate, collaborate / co-operate and federate with other societies/ N.G.O's/ trusts having the similar objectives in part or in whole;
19. To help in organizing conferences, Seminars, Meetings, Discussions, Debates, Study Courses, Exhibitions, Shows, Tour Trips, for the promotion and furtherance of aims and objectives of the Trust, particularly those relating to Moral, Environmental, Social, Economic/ Rural Development.
20. To conduct sponsored as well as non-sponsored Research/ Promotional/ Developmental and Training for aforementioned/ listed programmes with the support of State Govt./ Central Govt.
21. To organize Eco-development camps with the help of school going children as well as community and promote plantation movement / drive and Health Education and General Health Care including eradication of Communicable diseases.
22. To help conserve the fauna and flora of our State/ Country.
23. To visit the specific areas all over the country for making plans and projects relating to Pollution Monitoring and Control/ Rural/ Urban Sanitation, Public Health Programmes, Disaster Management and implement them with the Govt. assistance/ funding.
24. To prepare curriculum for the school and college level students in the areas of Environmental/ Vocational Education and to involve community

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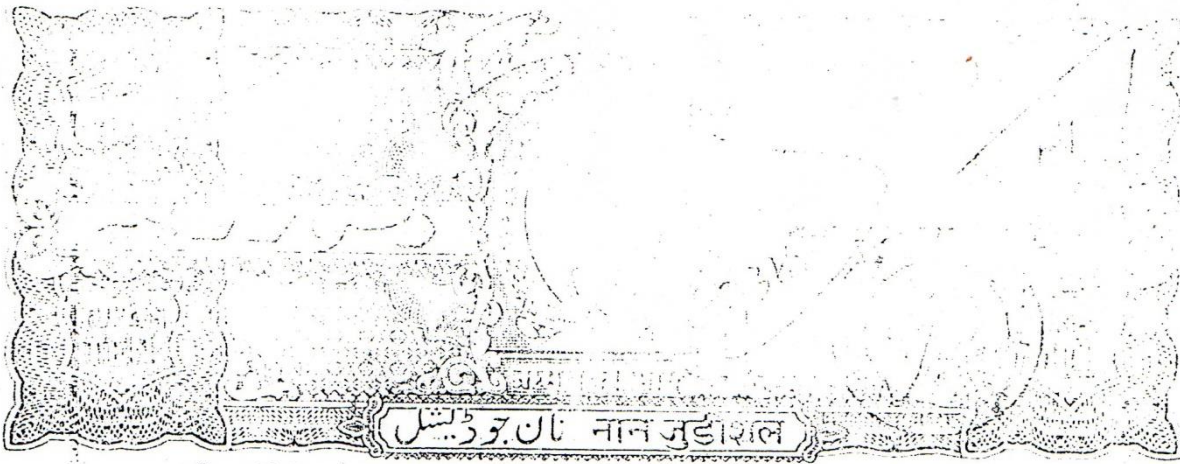
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for General Economic Development by way of professional training in different crafts and market promotion of the same. BP 840685

28. To work with the Govt. to implement the Road Development Programmes on the approved estimates of the competent authority particularly funded by Central Govt. and other Financial Organizations.

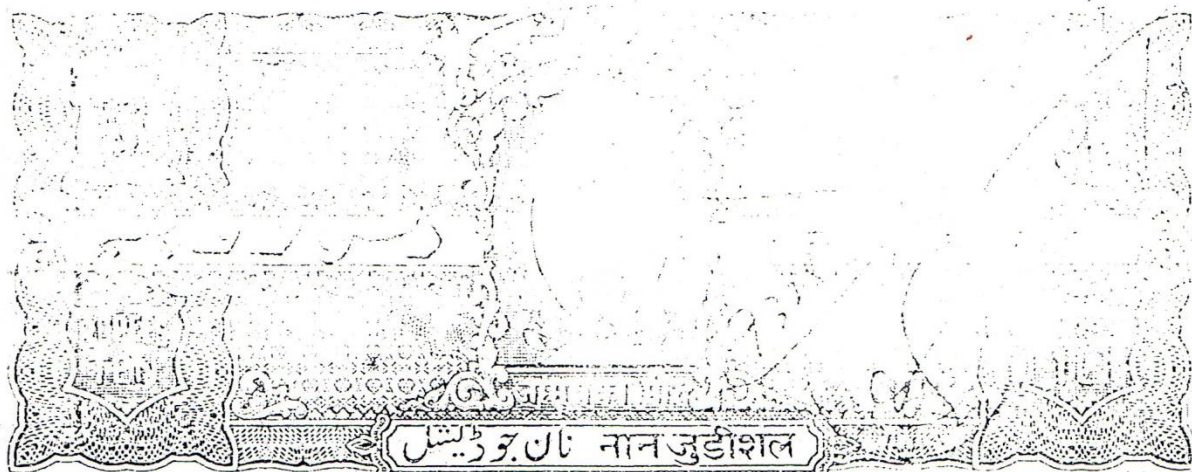

38. To explore ways for promotion of socioeconomic development in the community.
39. To under take, organize, conduct and facilitate, Courses, conference, lecture, research and education on various aspects and of science, technology, trust and other fields.
40. To train the downtrodden people in general for human resource development in view of the emerging needs such as database development,

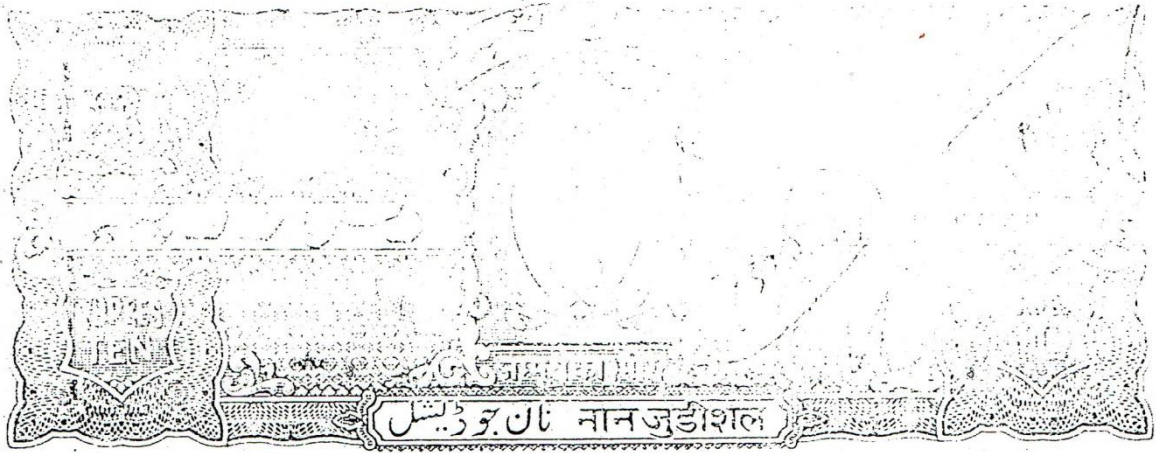
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64. To organized awareness camps, health camps, March, workshops, campaign and exhibition. BP 840669

73. To promote, encourage and facilitate research programmes and trainings in the field of public health, education and empowerment.
74. To arrange and organize religious, social and cultural programmes for all human being from time to time.
75. To create a sense of brotherhood, love, humanity, affection, cooperation and friendship amongst the members of the trust and the beneficiaries.

76. To make best efforts for promotion, development and protection of the beneficiaries/ target population and help them in distress.
 77. To help poor, widows, handicapped, orphans, old aged, mentally retired and under privileged section of the trust/community.
 78. To run/ operate different types of education program/schools like formal, non-formal, pre-school for the education development of under privileged children of the community/trust.
 79. To run the different types of health programmes to raise the health status of vulnerable groups, poor and needy.
 80. To work for the empowerment and sensitization of women, adolescents and children.
 81. To make up efforts for the education, welfare and development of women, children and backward community in both urban and rural areas throughout the country.
 82. To establish the medical facilities in the working locality (if required) such as family planning centers, dispensaries, hospitals etc.
 83. To run and open the schools for the welfare and uplift of the needy children and also run adult education programmes.
 84. To publish books, magazines, charts, issue related IEC (Information, Education and Communication) materials and other periodical illustration for generating the income for the trust for the benefit of its aims.
 85. To work and fight against discrimination based on Cast, Creed, Colour, Gender, Religion, Faith, Race & Nationality.
 86. To open / run / manage institute / collage of higher / professional / vocation education in any part of the country for providing quality education and training to youth and children.



87. To promote and protect natural herbs and plants by cultivation, preservation, storage, processing, demonstration, creating botanical garden and providing necessary training.
88. To establish / run / manage hospitals, health centres, mobile health clinics, research centre to provide health care, counseling and referral services for all kinds of illness and deceases.
89. To promote traditional therapies like Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Reiki etc.
90. To establish, build or manage Hostels, Short Stay Homes, Rehabilitation Centers, Shelters, Crèches, Child Care Centre or Children's Home, Counselling Centers and Help Line Centers for Women, Children, Old aged persons, Drug addicts and needy persons.
91. To work for the welfare of Agricultural workers, Farmers, Unorganized Labours, Industrial Labours and Migrated Labours.
92. To form women groups, youth groups, self help groups; old aged groups, adolescent groups, children groups/clubs, community leaders groups and group of volunteers.
93. To promote traditional games along with the contemporary sports among youth & others.
94. To work against the exploitation of Animals & Birds and make sincere efforts to protect them.
95. To celebrate annual day of the trust every year as cultural & social event.
96. To establish Citizen Forum (s) and Resident Welfare Association (s) for the development of high values of the Unity, Brotherhood, Communal Harmony and Peace.

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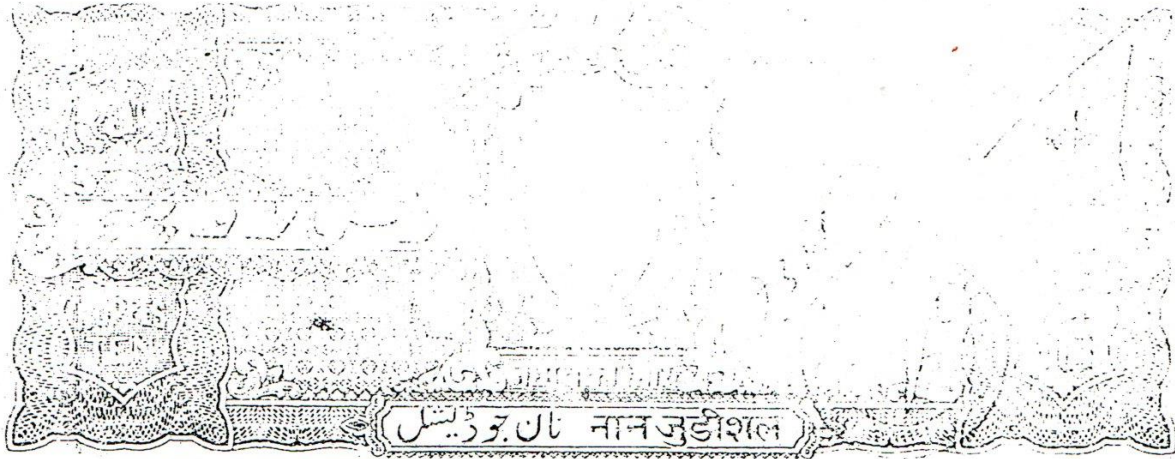


97. To promote and support voluntary donation of Blood, ^{BP-840672} eyes and other parts of human body for the charitable purpose.

AND GENERALLY to do in all public purposes for public benefit without any discrimination of Caste, Creed, Color, Gender, Religion, Faith, Race or any Nationality. That in case any of the objects of the Trust are held to be non charitable within the meaning of section 2 (15) of the Indian Trust Act, or any statutory modification (s) thereof, the Trustee (s) shall not carry out such objectives.

For furtherance of all or any of the aforesaid aims and objectives of the Trust, founder member/managing trustee shall have the authority to:-

1. To solicit, obtain and accept subscriptions, fee, grants, bequests, from trusts, persons/ banks/ local/domestic/foreign agencies, corporate bodies and Govt. agencies etc.
2. To arrange sell, transfer, exchange, mortgage, lease, let-out, dispose off and otherwise deal with the properties/ property whatsoever movable/ immovable belonging to the Trust.
3. To borrow or raise loans with or without interest / security, mortgage, charge, hypothecation or pledge all or any of the movable/ immovable properties/ property belonging to the Trust in any manner whatsoever required for the furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Trust.
4. To open and operate accounts in the bank(s) or deal with banks or financial institutions in any manner whatsoever required for the furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Trust
5. To open and conduct the branches and undertake such other activities for furtherance of all or any of the aims and objectives of the Trust which are legal and lawful;
6. To do all other lawful activities incidental or conducive to the attainment of aims and objectives of the Trust.



TRUST ADMINISTRATION AND POWER TO THE BOARD:

The **Board of Trustees** shall have power to:

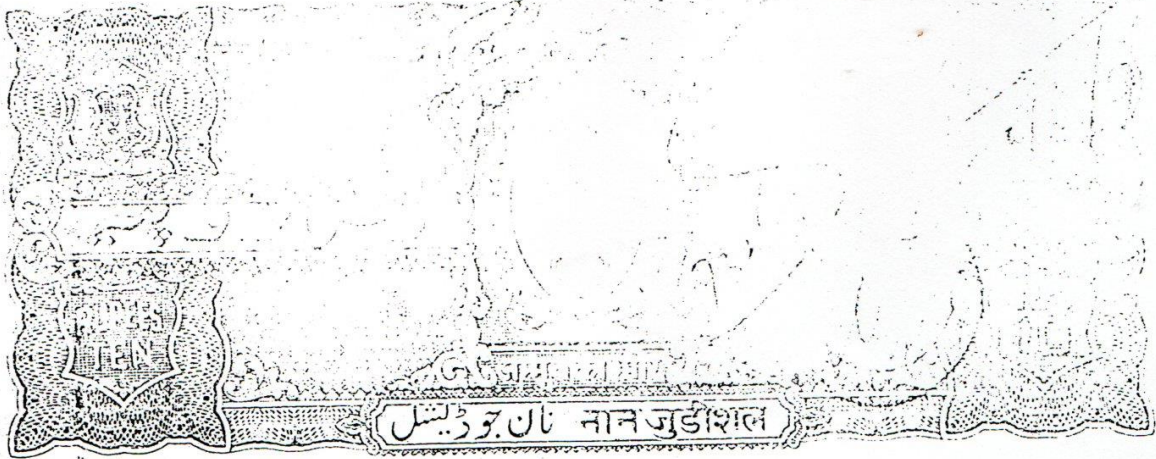
1. To administer the Trust, its properties and affairs and do all the things which will fulfill the performance of the objects for which the Trust is established and for this purpose the Board can apply the whole or any part of the Trust property towards the payment of the expenses of the Trust.
2. To open one or more bank accounts and operate the same or provide for operation of the said accounts by managing trustee/founder member.
3. To invest the Trust funds in the manner not prohibited by any provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
4. To buy, sell, mortgage, grant, lease, hire or otherwise alienate all or any of the properties of the Trust in its discretion for adequate consideration, so however any sale or alienation of immovable properties of the trust can be done only after obtaining the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.
5. To execute power of attorney or powers of attorney to any person for the purpose of executing, administering or managing the whole or any part of the Trust for the purpose of all or some among the objects of the Trust.
6. To borrow money with or without security and to repay the same.
7. To receive, collect and enforce recovery of all monies due or payable to the Trust and grant receipts and discharges therefore.
8. To settle, compromise or compound any disputes or refer the same to arbitration or litigation.
9. To receive voluntary contributions from any person or persons from India or outside, after complying with the statutory formalities, by way of donation, gifts or in any other manner and to hold the same upon Trust for the objects set forth herein.

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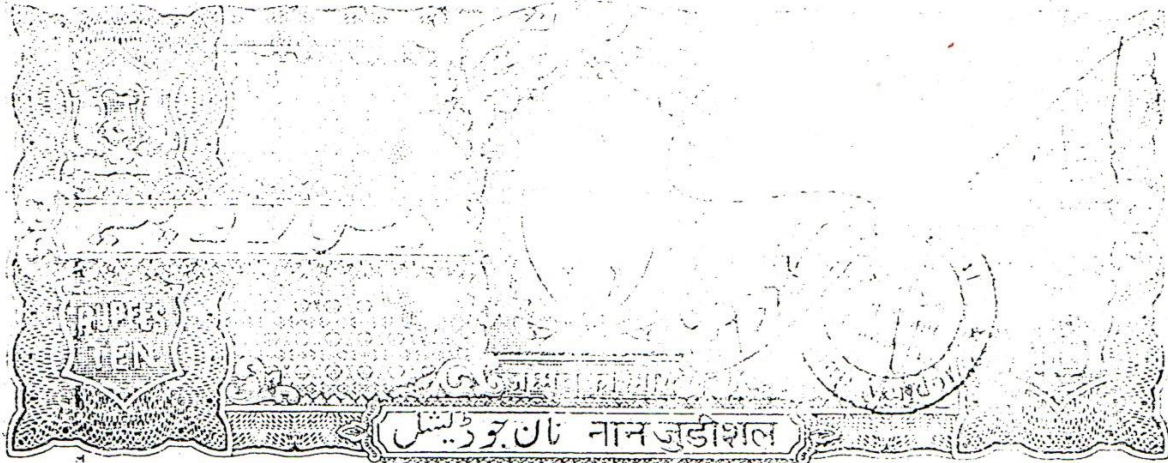

10. To appoint, suspend, dismiss or otherwise deal with the staff required for the administration of the Trust, to frame rules relating to their salaries and other benefits and generally to exercise all powers ancillary and incidental to effectively carry out the objects of the Trust.
 11. The Board shall have power to make and rescind rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust.
 12. No Trustee shall commit any act or breach of Trust of the Trust fund or property or cause any loss to the Trust property or commit fraud in the administration of the Trust fund / property.
 13. The Trustees shall hold honorary office and shall not be entitled to any Salary, allowances or perquisites, except for the reimbursement of actual expenses incurred in connection with attending to the Trust matters.
 14. The Board of Trustees will follow the instructions given by any donor who makes substantial contribution towards furtherance of the objects of the Trust, so long as such instructions are not detrimental to the attainment of the objects of the Trust and are in conformity with the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961.
 15. To frame rules and regulations for conducting the business of the Trust;
 16. To consider and recommend the applications for the membership as per rules for the Trust;
 17. To appoint/ promote/ punish suspend/ dismiss the employees and frame rules / regulations of the services for the employees of the Trust;
 18. To arrange for systematically maintenance of the accounts and preparation of Balance Sheet/ statements etc. and submission of the progress report and other obligatory returns to the concerned quarters;
 19. To see that the stock taking of all the properties/ stores is expedited;

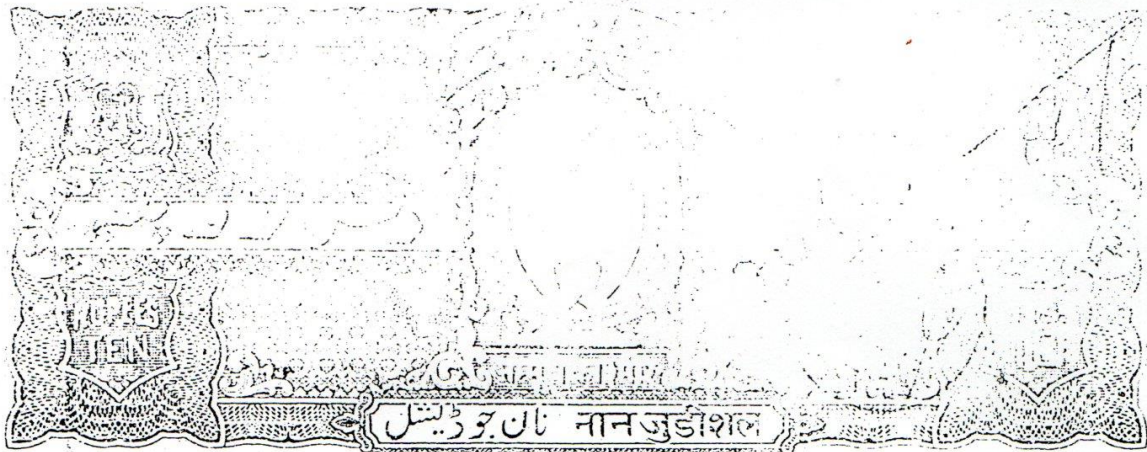


20. To insure the property/ properties of the Trust; BP 840675
21. To do all such things and acts that are necessary for conduct of the business of the Trust in furtherance of its aims and objectives;
22. The BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall be competent to delegate any of its powers to President/ Secretary/ or Sub-Committee constituted by it for any specific purpose;
23. Subject to the rules and regulations passed by the Trust at the general body meeting, the BOARD OF TRUSTEES shall have full authority to carry on the business as provided in the memorandum/ articles of association of the Trust;
24. Business of the urgent nature may be disposed off by circulation of the relevant papers amongst the members of managing committee provided that 3/4th majority of the members of the managing committee to ratify action passes the resolution. All resolutions passed accordingly by circulation will be ratified in the subsequent meetings of the managing committee;
25. In case any vacancy arise in the managing committee for any reason whatsoever, the remaining members shall be competent to function in the normal course, provided that there are at least as many members as are required for the quorum. Special general body meeting shall be called for filling up the vacancy by election.
26. For the management and administration of the Trust, the Trustees shall elect one amongst themselves for each of the offices of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. The term of office for President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be for a period of two years from their date of appointment and they may be reelected for further terms. No Trustee including the PRESIDENT shall hold more than one of the above offices at the same time. The persons holding these offices of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be under the administrative guidance and supervision of the President and will report to him directly.

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27. Any of the TRUSTEE wishing to be a member or Trustee of any other TRUST/SOCIETY/N.G.O will be free to do so however he shall not commit any act or breach of Trust of the Trust fund or property or cause any loss to the Trust property or commit fraud in the administration of the Trust fund / property while joining other trust(s)/Society(s)/N.G.O(s).
28. To appoint lawyer, pleaders, advocated to file and defend suit or suits filed for and against the Trust and or in the name of the Trust and also file suits for financial and other disputes or dues with different parties and signed executed such application, petition documents for such proceedings and delegate powers to the officers(s), employee(s), staff(s) and Trustee(s) for such proceedings(s) as required from time to time.
29. To appoint new member or members of Board of Trustees by a resolution and to discharge any of the Trustee, who become bankrupt or acts in any manner prejudicial to the interest or objects of the Trust or is convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or becomes of unsound mind or is otherwise unfit to continue as Trustee, by resolution passed by simple majority of members present and voting in the meeting of Board of Trustees.
30. To appoint from time to time on such terms and conditions as they may determine a Secretary, Manager, Executive Director, Director(s) and other officer(s) or members(s) of staff for carrying out the activities of the Trust and to remove at any time any such Secretary, Manager, Executive Director, Director(s) and other officer(s) or members(s) of staff.
31. The Trustees shall invest the Trust fund in government securities, saving certificates, fixed deposits or in any other form of investment authorized under provisions of INDIAN TRUST ACT and INDIAN INCOME TAX ACT, 1961, as they shall deem expedient.
32. All questions relating to the management of the Trust or the exercise of the powers vested in the Trust shall be decided at a meeting or, if necessary and expedient, by circulation. Every such question shall be decided by a majority of the Trustees present and voting in any meeting of Board of Trustees or by the circulation, as the case may be and any action or decision of such majority shall be as valid as if it was done or made by the all Trustees. The Chairman / Chairperson shall have a casting vote.



33. All matters not provided for in this Trust deed but necessary for the administration of the Trust or for giving effect to the objectives of the Trust may by resolution(s), made by the Board of Trustees carried by a special majority of two third of total number of the Trustees.

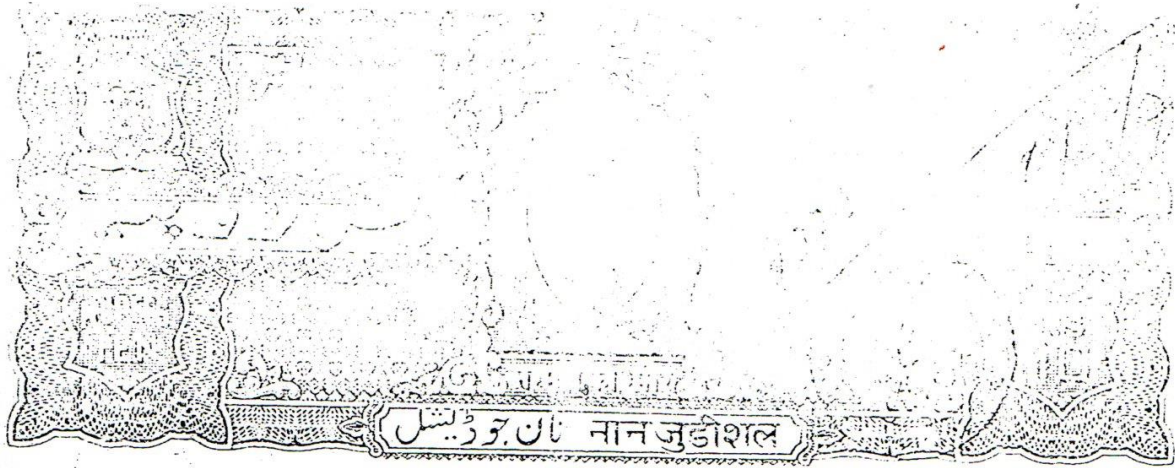
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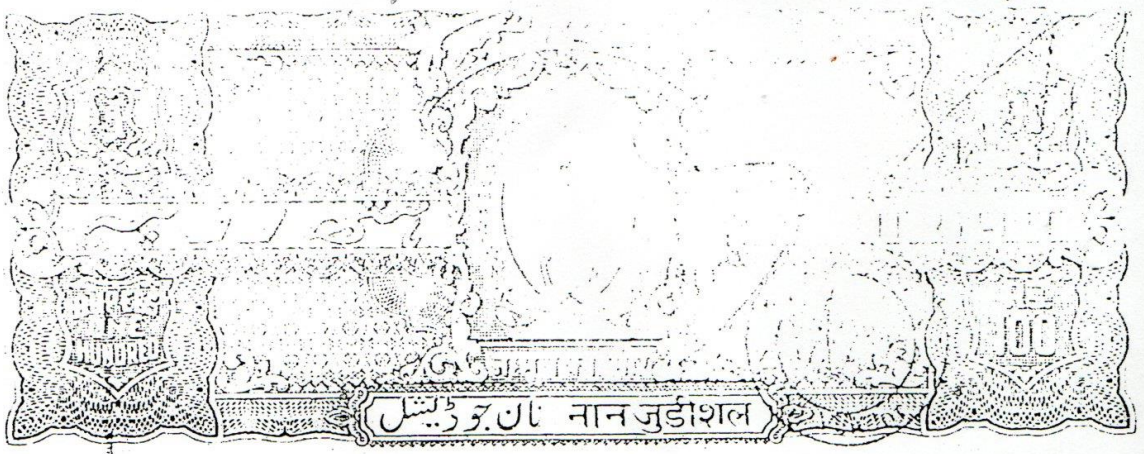
